Statistical Data Report for December 2024, Released February 2025

State Employment and Unemployment

Unemployment rates were higher in December in 6 states, lower in 2 states, and stable in 42 states and the District of Columbia, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported. Twenty-seven states and the District had jobless rate increases from a year earlier, 6 states had decreases, and 17 states had little change. The national unemployment rate changed little over the month at 4.1 percent but was 0.3 percentage point higher than in December 2023.




