

#### **State Employment and Unemployment**

STATE EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT -- February 2024 Unemployment rates were higher in February in 3 states, lower in 3 states, and stable in 44 states and the District of Columbia, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported. Twenty-eight states had jobless rate increases from a year earlier, 3 states had decreases, and 19 states and the District had little change. The national unemployment rate increased by 0.2 percentage point to 3.9 percent and was 0.3 point higher than in February 2023. Nonfarm payroll employment increased in 4 states and was essentially unchanged in 46 states and the District of Columbia in February 2024. Over the year, nonfarm payroll employment increased in 25 states and was essentially unchanged in 25 states and the District.






