About LAUS


The Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) program is a federal-state cooperative effort that produces monthly estimates of employment and unemployment. The estimates are based on the resident, civilian labor force in Indiana, which excludes people in institutions and in the armed forces. The most recent month of data displayed in these maps is preliminary data.

The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) of the U.S. Department of Labor is responsible for the concepts, definitions, technical procedures, validation, and publication of the estimates that state employment security agencies prepare under agreement with BLS. 


Employment Change in Indiana December 2019 to December 2020



Employment Percent Change in Indiana December 2019 to December 2020




Employment Change per Economic Growth Region December 2019 to December 2020
